

Gulf Coast Creation Care Membership Form

Mission: To focus the Gulf Coast community's moral attention on the climate crisis and to mobilize all people toward bold and just action.

We are a faith-based alliance of disparate faith traditions responding locally to the global climate crisis. We understand that transformational change is necessary to effectively address global warming, and we hope that you will join in this collaboration to provide the foundation for the profound spiritual change that will be essential to heal God's creation and care for those affected by our changing climate.

Faith communities and individuals who belong to a faith community that does NOT desire to join GCCC can establish Full Membership with Gulf Coast Creation care by:

- Affirming the mission of GCCC and requesting full membership;
- Donating the suggested annual dues of \$100 (congregation) / \$25 (individual) to GCCC or (if financial dues are a hardship to the congregation or individual) committing work hours to GCCC projects; and
- Sending a representative to attend at least one GCCC meeting annually.

Full members can serve as officers, attend meetings, contribute to discussions and consensus decisions, and participate in projects.

Individuals not affiliated with a faith community and non-faith-based groups can request Associate Membership with Gulf Coast Creation care by:

- Affirming the mission of GCCC and requesting associate membership, and
- Donating annual dues of \$100 (group) / \$25 (individual) to GCCC or (if financial dues are a hardship) committing work hours to GCCC projects

Associate members can attend meetings, contribute to discussions and consensus decisions, and participate in projects.
